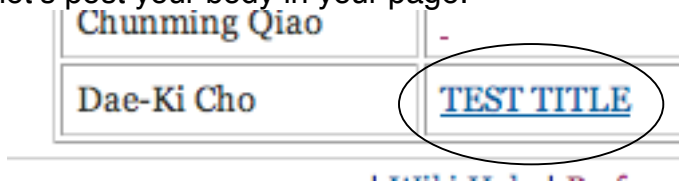

Summary: *

3. Press browse and find your file and press upload.

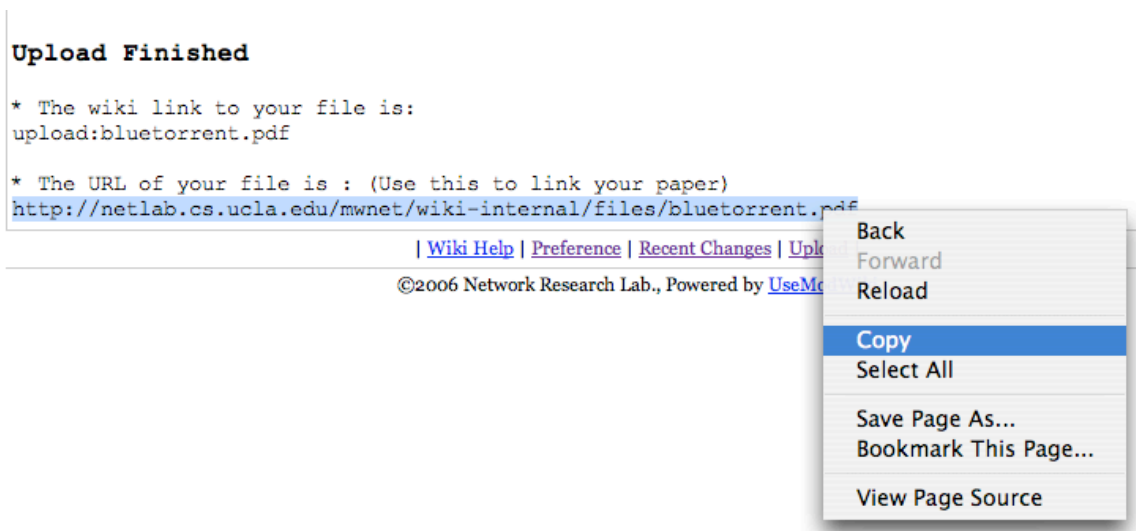


File Upload Page

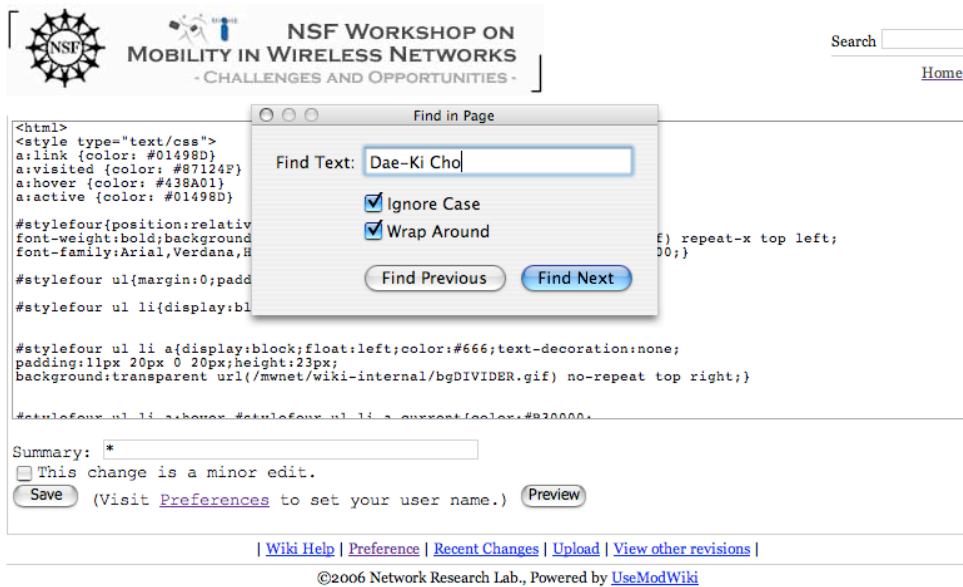
